

Handelsbanken Developed Markets Index Criteria (A1 EUR)

The fund is an index fund that tracks the Solactive ISS ESG Screened Paris Aligned Developed Markets Index with the aim of generating returns that over time correspond as closely as possible to the returns of the index. Given that investments are made in foreign equities denominated in currencies other than the fund's base currency, fund investments are associated with currency risk. The aim of the index is to reflect the performance of the developed equity markets worldwide, while excluding those companies that do not fulfill the sustainability requirements of the index. The fund is reported as an Article 9 fund pursuant to EU regulation 2019/2088 on sustainability-related disclosures in the financial services sector (SFDR).

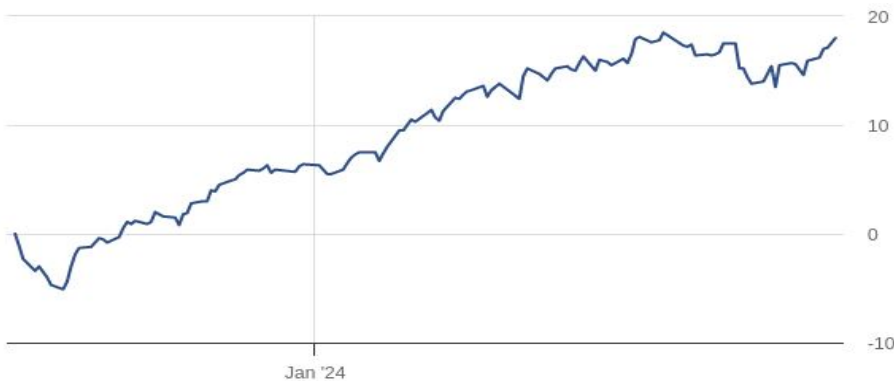

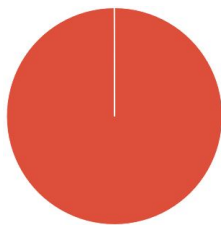
